Consumer Price Index – August 2013

Information released today by Statistics Canada indicates that the Yellowknife All-Items Consumer Price Index rose 1.9% from August 2012. By comparison, the annual price increase was 1.1% for Canada, 1.2% for Edmonton and 2.1% for Whitehorse.

Compared to August 2012, consumer prices in Yellowknife increased for all major components with the exception of household operations & furnishings and health & personal care. The highest price increases over the last 12 months were for food (5.1%) and transportation (3.0%).

While Yellowknife food prices remained relatively stable in 2011 and 2012, they have trended upward since the start of 2013. Since December 2012, food prices have increased 6 of the last 8 months.

In contrast, transportation prices continued their decline from their peak experienced in June, decreasing 0.2% between July and August 2013.

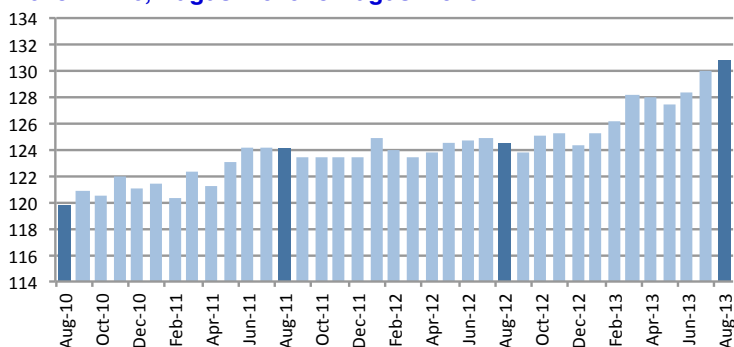
Overall, Yellowknife prices increased 0.1% from last month.

CPI values for Yellowknife and Whitehorse include estimates of price changes for owned accommodation based on the price of rental accommodation. As a result, the all-items indexes published for these centers are not strictly comparable to those for Canada and Edmonton.

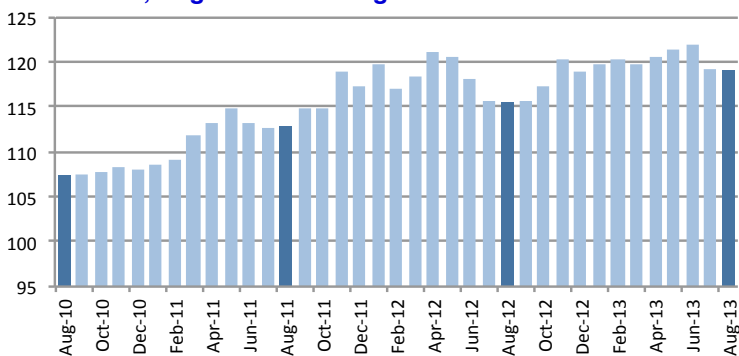
